Directions to Play Day Facility

From Detroit or Points East via I-96

Proceed west on I-96 to northbound US-127; follow US-127 north to East Lansing. Take the Trowbridge Road exit. Follow Trowbridge Road east to Michigan State University. Turn left on Harrison Road, right on to West Shaw Lane, Duffy Daugherty Football Building will be located on the right, directly across from Ralph Young Field.

From Grand Rapids or Points West via I-96

Proceed east on I-96 to eastbound I-69. Proceed east on I-69 to southbound US-127. Take US-127 south to East Lansing. Take the Trowbridge Road exit. Follow Trowbridge Road east to Michigan State University. Turn left on Harrison Road, right on to West Shaw Lane, Duffy Daugherty Football Building will be located on the right, directly across from Ralph Young Field.

From Kalamazoo or Points South via I-69

Proceed east on I-94 to northbound I-69. Take I-69 north to Lansing. Take I-496 east to the Trowbridge Road exit. Follow Trowbridge Road east to Michigan State University. Turn left on Harrison Road, right on to West Shaw Lane, Duffy Daugherty Football Building will be located on the right, directly across from Ralph Young Field.

Play Day Parking

Please Park in the South Stadium Lot, located just south of Spartan Stadium just off of West Shaw Lane. This parking lot is located directly across from the Duffy Daugherty Football Building.
